Oversee enrollment process, homework assistance and makes recommendations for improvement in overall State After School sites budgets and programming. Also, this person will support in uploading attendance into the state database system (TransAct). Assumes responsibility for grant oversight; budget management; and coordination with schools and various city-wide private and governmental entities/officials. Reviews, monitors and aligns implementation of system-wide enactment of federal, state, and local

- early childhood mandates and requirements. Works in conjunction with other NHPS offices to support student achievement.
- 5 part time Cert. Staff to facilitate academic activities and facilitate enrichment activities with support from 2 part time Paras who will monitor activities, assist with homework and transitions.

Fixed Cost

- Medicare at 1.45% of staffing allocation (\$334.00)
- Workmen's compensation at 0.007 of staffing allocation (\$180.00)
- FICA at 6.2% of staffing allocation (\$334.00)
